The Officers and Board of Trustees of Temple Sinai look forward to having you worship with us during the 5778 High Holy Day season this year. The holidays commence on Wednesday, September 20, 2017. Services will be conducted by Rabbi Aviva Bass and Cantorial Soloist Margaret Schmitt, joined by our professional and volunteer choir.

On Wednesday, September 20th, we will have an Erev Rosh Hashanah dinner at 5:30pm (details to follow). This dinner is not included as part of your holiday tickets and a separate reservation is required. Erev Rosh Hashanah services will start at 8:00pm. There will be only one service for each holiday on the High Holy Days. First day Rosh Hashanah service will be on September 21st at 9:30am. The service for Kol Nidre will be on Friday, September 29th at 8:00pm, and Yom Kippur services will be on Saturday, September 30th at 9:30am. Yizkor prayers will be recited during the Yom Kippur service.

The Family and Children's service will be at 1:30pm on both the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur day. You may choose to attend the Family service (use separate reservation form) if you plan to attend with your children or grandchildren.

If you plan to sit with other Temple Sinai members, your request for adjoining seats must be submitted in the same envelope. Please read the enclosed Schedule of Services and Seating Reservation Forms carefully, before you fill out your request.

If you are a **special needs** member, please indicate specific details so that the Committee can provide you with the most appropriate seating available.

Please mail or bring your RESERVATION FORM to the Temple no later than Friday, July 14th. The Committee requests your cooperation in picking up your tickets. The tickets will be available in the Temple office beginning Friday, August 18th from 10:00am – 3:00pm.

The Board of Trustees reminds you that only members in good standing, who have satisfied their Temple financial obligations by June 30, 2017, will be eligible for tickets. If you have any questions, please call the Temple office at 561-276-6161 ext. 114.
