Dear Temple Sinai Friends,

We are all familiar with the words “Never Again” as related to the Holocaust. In order to ensure that this most horrendous event in Jewish and world history never happens again, it is vital that we “Never Forget”. That is why there is a day, Yom HaShoah, dedicated to remembering. This year Yom HaShoah falls on **April 24, 2025**. There are many ways to commemorate the Holocaust. These include attending our Temple Sinai Holocaust service or other Holocaust events that are offered by various communities, theaters and other media outlets.

Another very meaningful way to remember the Shoah is to participate in Temple Sinai Brotherhood’s Shoah Yellow Candle™ project. Every Temple member will have the opportunity to obtain a Shoah Yellow Candle™ at the Temple, in advance at our services (and events) from Brotherhood. Or by leaving a message at 561-276-6161 ext 133. Additional candles for family and friends can be obtained. You may light the candle on the eve of **Yom HaShoah on Wednesday evening April 23** or bring it to services on **Friday night April 25, 2025** when we will light all of the candles brought to Temple. Additional candles will be available that night for those who did not obtain one prior to the service, or for those who would like to light another one as part of the service. If you cannot attend our service, you can either light the candle at home while watching the service on our YouTube stream or light the candle on the actual day by yourself.

The Brotherhood is also asking that, in memory of the Shoah, **you make a donation, in multiples of Cha’i (see form below)** to defray the cost of the candles and as a remembrance of someone you may have lost, or known, or the 6 million souls. This will also help Brotherhood, and our Temple, to continue the good work of creating and sustaining a strong Jewish community here in Palm Beach County. We will also donate a portion of the proceeds to the “Anne Frank Center” to “empower young people to become courageous change makers by fostering empathy, understanding and action against intolerance”. Please mark your check and the envelope with the words “Yellow Candle Project.” May the light of our Jewish community never go out. May the light of the souls that were lost never diminish.
